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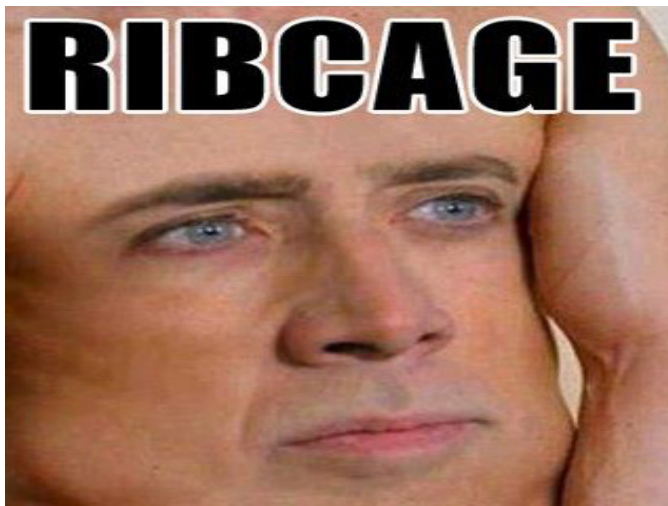

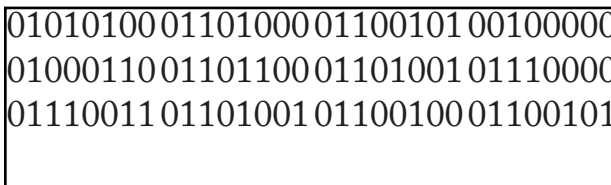
Fill in the grid so each column, row, and 3x3 box has the numbers 1 through 9.
